



APPENDIX 2

RF Legal Requirements for Road Transport

Purpose

To outline legislative requirements that define a legal framework for road safety in the RF and establish:

- key requirements to ensure road safety, including competency and occupational fitness of employees directly involved transport operation;
- requirements on medical support in road safety;
- requirements on the content of driver inductions and arrangements to prepare staff for safe work and vehicles for safe operation;
- obligation to prepare an RTI Prevention Plan, periodically monitor its implementation, and thoroughly analyse RTI causes and conditions;
- cargo transportation safety requirements.

This document is intended to help verify compliance with legislation, corporate standards and technical requirements, as well as to provide consultations to Managers.
